SBCSG was established on 3rd December 1993 with only 14 members.

Membership is open to any person who is a Malaysian citizen residing in Sarawak who has/had breast cancer, healthcare professionals and any caregiver who is interested to assist in the society.

OBJECTIVES

1. To give support to the members who have problems physically, emotionally and spiritually.
2. To organize talks on health education and provide counseling to those need.
3. To create awareness and disseminate information to the public regarding breast self-examination and early detection of breast cancer.
4. To Plan and carry out talk, seminars outings, meeting and activities and to co-operate with authorities concerned on related matters.
5. To organize visit members who warded in the hospital or at home; and render the assistance if necessary.



BANGLO MATAHARI HALFWAY HOME (ANJUNG SAYANG)

- Banglo Matahari Halfway Home (Anjung Sayang) is for needy breast cancer patients seeking oncology treatment at Sarawak General Hospital (SGH) from outstation who needed a place to stay while being treated at the hospital.
- Anjung Sayang location is strategic, about 0.5 km from SGH.
- The home has three bedrooms, each equipped with three beds, kitchen and 1 bathroom. Every patient admitted will be booked into a room together with an accompanying caregiver. Basic equipment and kitchen utensils provided.
- Anjung Sayang home has provided support to 100 people (cancer patients and caregivers) up to August.
